The Market Chamber wants you to have control over your data and is also concerned with your privacy and the security of your information and, to that effect, this Statement will tell you what information we collect and how we use it on the Market Chamber Website and on CAM Digital.

1. Glossary

In this section we present some important concepts for you to understand our Statement:

Market Chamber Website: is the website of the Market Chamber, which includes CAM Digital.

CAM Digital: is the area logged on to the Website of the Market Chamber, which consists of an electronic platform that allows all the procedural acts of the arbitration proceedings to be performed digitally.

You: when we say “you” in this Policy, we are talking about anyone who visits the Market Chamber Website or registered for CAM Digital.

Information: is all information, whether personal data or otherwise that You will provide to us, that we will obtain from third parties during your use of the Service or created from the use of the Market Chamber Website and CAM Digital.

2. What types of information do we collect and how do we use this information?

3. With whom do we share the data?

The Market Chamber has partners that help us provide services with the excellence and quality that You and our customers expect:

Thus, we share your data with some entities such as:

- Our suppliers and service providers;
- Parties involved in the arbitral proceedings;
- Public and judicial authorities to comply with court orders.

4. How is the information stored?

The Market Chamber will store your information safely for the period necessary to achieve the purposes and to comply with the provisions of the contracts and the legislation applicable to the arbitration proceedings.

5. How do we respond to legal requirements?

If any law enforcement, administrative or judicial authority (e.g., civil police, civil judge, federal revenue office, accounting court), whether from Brazil or abroad, requests access to your information and such request is legally supported (that is, the authority can request and the Market Chamber is required to deliver), the Market Chamber may share your information.

6. How do we protect your information?

The Market Chamber uses its best efforts to respect and protect your information against loss, theft or any form of misuse of your information, as well as against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction.

We use principles such as Privacy by design and Security by design, respecting your privacy and protecting your data in our internal processes as a whole.

We only treat your information with a high degree of security, implementing best practices in use in the industry for data protection, such as encryption techniques, monitoring and periodic security tests. However, it is not possible to completely guarantee the non-occurrence of interceptions and violations of the systems and databases of the Market Chamber, since the internet has its security structure in permanent improvement.

7. How will we notify you in the event of changes to this Statement?

This Statement may be updated and the latest version will always be the one that will be in effect.
